It causes unhealthy and already schools are started in car sheds, rooms, upstairs etc, and specifying only per child 1 square meter is nothing but encouraging again in smaller peace of place causing safety compromise and encouraging old practices to open in a small places creating unhealthy and uncontrollable. |

All the educational institutions running during the academic year | • One year of time bound may not be feasible and some requirement may not be possible as additional space and required resources may not be able to be fulfilled within any given years. |

The school should not be made mandatory to ensure safety by third party who has no control by private school authority. |
| 5. | Part IV A, No including those for the recognition renewal shall require a processing fee and paid online. 1.Pre-Primary education only. | The recognition or renewal shall not arise for pre-primary as its only registration process, the pre-primary has no curriculum and prescribed syllabus, hence matter of renewal of recognition and processing fee does not apply, and hence we demand to remove the Rs. 2000 as processing fee. |
| 6. | No mentioning of distance between existing school and new school for permission. | A minimum of 500 mts in the city to be considered if there are existing School, and 1 KM if it's in rural areas for providing new school permission, this has to be mentioned as demand and supply is more causing per child expenditure in the existing schools or new school will be more due to less strength and high expectation with minimum facility indirectly it burdens the parents of the pupils. |
